PRINCIPLES FOR THE REQUIRED HIST 201 AND HIST 202 COURSES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

ENROLLED UNDER THE INTERNATIONAL STUDENT QUOTA

As per Article 5, clause (ı) of the Law No:2547 on Higher Education, all undergraduate students are offered the HIST 201 and HIST 202 courses in their curricula for at least two semesters.

However, in lieu of the HIST 201 and HIST 202 courses, international students admitted to the English-medium undergraduate programs at Özyeğin University are required to take the HIST 303 and HIST 304 courses. The HIST 303 and HIST 304 courses are offered by the Humanities and Social Sciences Department at the Faculty of Social Sciences. These courses are subject to the following principles:

- 1-** In lieu of the HIST 201 and HIST 202 courses, international students are offered the HIST 303 and HIST 304 courses for 2 hours a week. These courses are 4 ECTS credits. Students who take HIST 303 and HIST 304 cannot register for the HIST 201 and HIST 202 courses.
- 2-** Students who graduated from high schools in Turkey must take the HIST 201 and HIST 202 courses. Student Services identifies these students and assists them in registering for the appropriate courses.
- 3-** Students registered in Turkish-medium undergraduate programs must take the HIST 201 and HIST 202 courses.
- 4-** These directives were accepted by the University Senate on July 22, 2020, during its meeting no: 2020/09.
- 5-** In the absence of relevant provisions for special cases not covered in these principles, the decision will be made by the School of Languages or the respective Faculty Executive Board.
